

**Henna Is Not Black!
"Black Henna" is Not Safe!**

"Black Henna" is a highly concentrated form of para-phenylenediamine (PPD).

It is NOT natural and it is NOT safe.

Using PPD on the skin is ILLEGAL.

Just one application of "black henna" gives you up to a **50% chance** of developing an allergy to PPD for life.

Allergic Reaction to PPD:

- Can happen to anyone
- Will make you allergic for the rest of your life
- Can happen after the first application
- Can get worse over time
- Can be severe enough to require hospitalization
- Can cause cross-sensitivities to other substances
- Will make you allergic to oxidative hair dyes

EVEN IF you do not experience a reaction after getting “Black Henna,” you may have still developed an allergy. The next time you come in contact with it, you may have a severe reaction.



Symptoms:

- Reaction occurring 1-30 days after application
- Burning, itching, and blistering
- Weeping sores
- Scabs or scaly skin
- Permanent scarring
- Permanent loss of pigmentation
- If applied near face, swelling of the face and eyes, trouble breathing



If You Spot Someone Doing “Black Henna”:

- Record the location, date, and time.
- Try to get a photo of the person, materials, and booth.
- If you can get a photo of the person’s face while they are applying “black henna” to someone, do so.
- Contact the local health department and provide them with the information you have collected.
- If “black henna” is being offered on the property of a hotel, amusement part, or festival, contact those in charge.

If You Believe You Are Experiencing A Reaction:

- See a doctor immediately.
- Schedule an appointment with an allergist.
- Provide the doctor with as much of the information in the above section as possible.
- Contact the local health department as above.
